Arcata's Measure W would essentially end fluoridation of Arcata's municipal water supply. It is supported by the measure's sponsor, Arcatans for Safe Drinking Water, Northern Humboldt Greens, and the Humboldt Libertarians. It is opposed by both Humboldt County Republicans and Democrats, as well as California Nurses Association, Humboldt-Del Norte Medical Society and several Dental Associations.
